Reflecting on God's Word

Is Paul serious? Can you imagine being content with “weaknesses, insults, hardships, and persecutions?” (2Cor 12:10) Paul could have been proud of all that God revealed to him, and of all that he accomplished in spreading the gospel. But instead he boasts about his weaknesses. He knows that all the good work he has done have been accomplished by Christ. So he accepted suffering, rejection, setbacks and persecution because they helped him see how much Christ was doing through him.

We can learn a lot from St. Paul. Remember how Jesus said to love your neighbor as yourself. Paul loved himself in the good sense of accepting his faults and weaknesses. He was always aware that he once persecuted Christians. But that fault enabled him to experience God's forgiveness.

St. Paul says that when he is weak, then he is strong. He knows that God will still work through him, showing God's power to heal the sick and draw converts to Christ, in spite of Paul's weaknesses. Paul did what he could to encourage others to follow Jesus, but he knew the results of his preaching and healing were up to God. When you think that you would fail at spreading the faith, remember Paul and give your weaknesses to God. Then see what he can do!

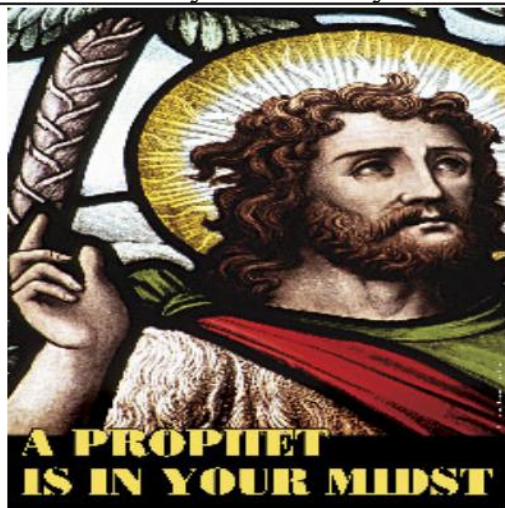

¿Pablo está hablando en serio? ¿Te imaginas estar contento con “las debilidades, los insultos, las necesidades, las persecuciones y las dificultades?” (2 Cor 12,10) Pablo podría haberse sentido orgulloso de todo lo que Dios le reveló y de todo lo que logró al difundir el evangelio. Pero en cambio presume de sus debilidades. Sabe que toda la buena obra que ha realizado ha sido realizada por Cristo. Así que, aceptó el sufrimiento, el rechazo, los reveses y la persecución porque le ayudaron a ver cuánto estaba haciendo Cristo a través de él.

Podemos aprender mucho de San Pablo. Recuerda cómo Jesús dijo que amaras a tu prójimo como a ti mismo. Pablo se amó a sí mismo en el buen sentido de aceptar sus faltas y debilidades. Siempre fue consciente de que una vez persiguió a los cristianos. Pero esa falla le permitió experimentar el perdón de Dios.

San Pablo dice que cuando es más débil, es más fuerte. Sabe que Dios seguirá obrando a través de él, mostrando el poder de Dios para sanar a los enfermos y atraer conversos a Cristo, a pesar de las debilidades de Pablo. Pablo hizo lo que pudo para animar a otros a seguir a Jesús, pero sabía que los resultados de su predicación y curación dependían de Dios. Cuando pienses que fracasarías en difundir la fe, recuerda a Pablo y entrega tus debilidades a Dios, y ¡verás lo que puede hacer!

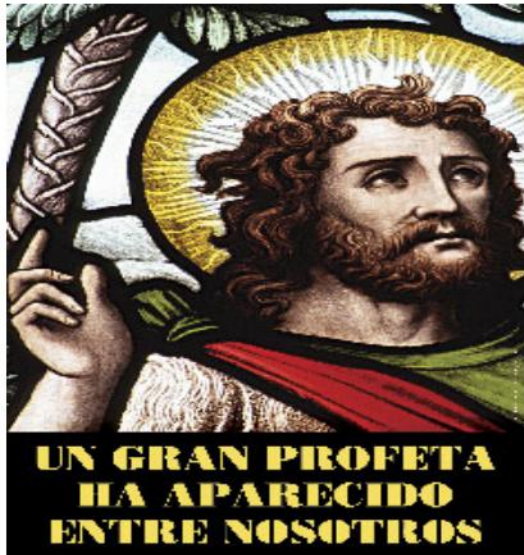

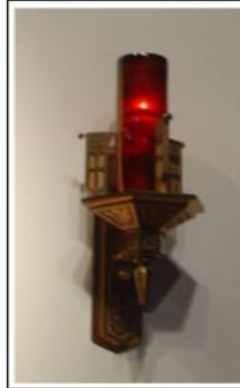

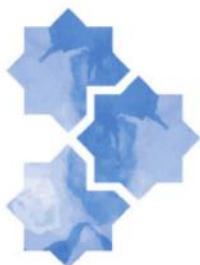
